GROWING SCOPE OF ENERGY WITHIN EGYPT

Egypt has significant natural energy resources, both in traditional fossil fuels and renewable energy. However, as the population and domestic energy demands continue to grow, the importance of diversifying energy sources to enhance the country's energy security is highlighted.

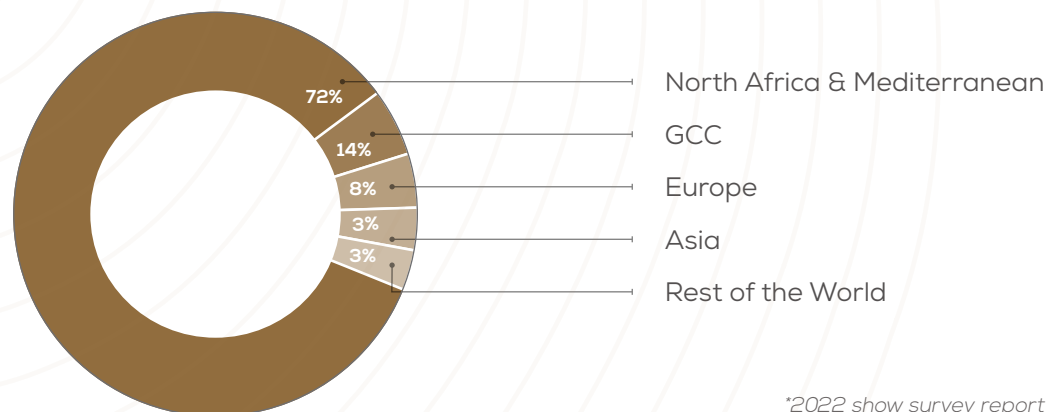
